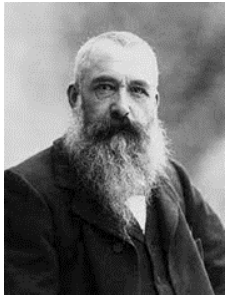

Warm Colours
