I wanted to update you on a couple of issues as we approach the end of term, in order to help parents plan.

Reports and Open Afternoon –

Reports will be coming out to Parents on Friday July 15th. I am currently reading and signing them as it is great to read about the hard work of the children and the progress they have made this year. On **Monday July 18th**, parents of all classes will be invited to come into school, straight after school, to their children's classes and to see their books over the year. This is an informal chance to talk to your child's teacher and look at their work.
