Your child can learn to play for the equivalent of **less than £1 per day** and you can choose an instrument package that includes an instrument, music book, music stand, book bag and instrument maintenance cover, or if you already have an instrument you can just pay for lessons. There are reductions for children eligible for Pupil Premium.
