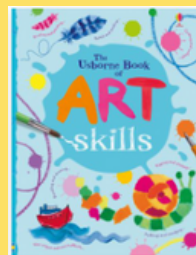
Here is our fourth newsletter dedicated to reading at Parkwood.

BOOK FAIR



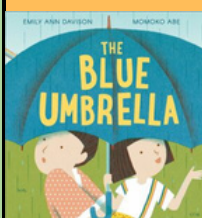

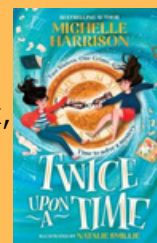
