

## School Performance Data - Historic Results from Parkwood Primary School

As of 2020-2021, Parkwood Primary School is an all through Community Primary School. Previously the schools made up Park Wood Schools Federation, which consisted of a separate Infant and Junior School.

There were no statutory assessments in 2019-20. Information passed on between Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 and between Key Stage 2 and Key stage 3, were Teacher Assessments. This was as a result of the fact that statutory assessments were cancelled due to Coronavirus pandemic.
