The colour run will be a sponsored event to raise money for the school. Last year, our families raised enough money to install new playground markings, which have really encouraged our children to be active during playtime.



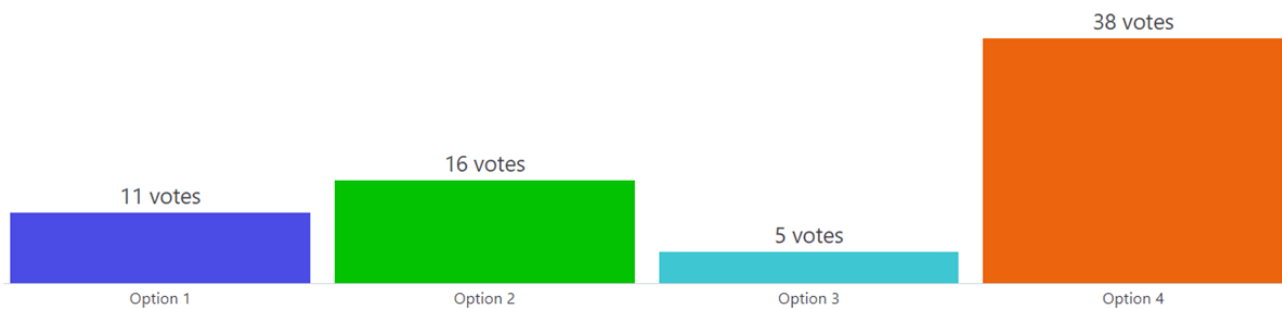
This year, we will be raising money to enhance playtimes even more. Our Smart School Council Comms team have been collating the children's views as to what they'd like to see added to their playground:
